



The Greenville Shrine Hospital is the primary hospital that we support using our various fund-raising events here in Gloucester each year. The hospital invites our Nobles and their families and friends to an Open House each year to become educated on the workings of a Shrine Hospital and how the funds we raise are used for the support of hospital mission. Elsewhere in this issue of the Hi-Noble, you will find an article by Noble Keith Webb of our Tidewater Shrine Club. Keith has been the Khedive Shrine Hospital Representative for seven years and is a strong supporter of this road trip. Please read it and then seriously consider joining us on this fun and educational trip.

So far, we have had about 20 Shriners and friends who have indicated their interest in attending, but we need about 20 more to make the trip worthwhile. Here are the details:

A luxury 55 passenger bus will pick up our first passengers early in the morning on March 6, 2026, in Gloucester, VA and proceed to the Khedive Shrine Center to pick up the remaining attendees. The group then travels to our hotel in Greenville, arriving later in the afternoon. We unload there and then take a short drive to the Meet and Greet at the Shrine Hospital which is nearby. Heavy hors d'oeuvres and drinks will be served, and we can meet our Hospital hosts and some of the patients as well as participants from other Shrine Temples and Clubs.

The next morning, we rise and have a full breakfast at the hotel, check out of our rooms, and proceed to the Hospital for registration and then start our program. There will be presentations by the Doctors and Staff and then tours of the operating rooms and other facilities. You will be honored to meet patients and their families as well. At noon, there will be a meal in the hospital and after we finish eating, we will board our motor coach for the trip back to our Shrine Center and Gloucester.

The cost of the trip is minimal as our Club has had a generous donation which was given with the idea that all Shriners should visit a Shrine Hospital to appreciate the reason that we are members of this large philanthropic organization. Plus, we will receive our "Silver Crutch" to pin to our fez.

The cost for the trip is low - \$100/person for the bus, \$160 for a double room (includes tax), and \$25 per person for registration (covers the hospital's food and beverage costs of our visit). You get to go on a 1200 mile round-trip in a comfortable motor coach almost free.

James Edward Howell, Jr. Friend, Masonic Brother, Fellow Shriner


James Edward Howell, Jr. (Jimmy) began his Masonic Career began in the early 1950's when he began to gain an interest watching his brother-in-law Hunter Darden, Jr. as he was accepted into Franklin Masonic Lodge #151 A.F.& A.M. Through all of this he learned that his paternal grandfather, William Fletcher Howell had also been a Mason and was also a member of the same lodge, Franklin Masonic Lodge #151 A.F.&A.M. and a true interest was sparked. Jimmy and his good friend, Darrell Shultz decided to petition the Lodge together and both were accepted. Jimmy immediately went through the Scottish Rite and soon after joined the Khedive Temple Shriners and is a proud member of Khedive to this day. Jimmy was elected into the Khedive Temple on May 29, 1957, and was initiated on June 29, 1957, thus making him a 68-year Shriner. He is currently a member of the Century Club which is the oldest (not in age but in time as a member) of the current roster of membership in Khedive Temple. In 2007, Jimmy was made a life member of Khedive Temple Shrine.

His good friend, Noble Raeford Eure encouraged him to join what was then known as the Khedive Air Wing to transport patients to hospitals. There, Jimmy logged countless hours transporting crippled and burned patients to the Shrine hospitals such as Greenville, SC and Cincinnati, Ohio. The Khedive Air Wing is a part of the Transportation Unit known as the Roadrunners. Jimmy once stated, "There is a statue at the Shrine Center called, 'Walking Tall.' It shows a Shriner walking with a child in his arms. On the two trips that I took a little blond-haired girl who had been born with club feet and twisted legs to the Orthopedic Hospital in Greenville, S.C., she had casts on both legs to correct her deformity. I personified that statue as I picked that little girl up out of the airplane and carried her to the terminal building where a van from the hospital was waiting to carry her to the hospital. As I walked towards the terminal building, with her little arms around my neck, I knew what it meant to be a Shriner. Walking Tall took on a whole new meaning for me." He also recalls how the Air Traffic Control (ATC) people treated him on those Angel Flights. As all trips were made on Instrument Flight Plans, the ATC people would monitor every minute and mile of the flight and they were designated as "Angel Flights." They normally gave Angel Flights priority in sequencing. There are many stories of how a Shriner like Jimmy and so many others have made a difference in other people's lives that this could go on and on. Just know, get involved, be kind and take an active part in life itself.

It is noted that Jimmy flew for 53 years and, at the age of 75, decided to hang up his flight jacket for good and sold his beloved Cessna 182 Skylane N21107, AKA Angel Flight 21107. He did admit that he had tears in his eyes as he watched that Skylane depart Franklin Airport with the new owner at the controls.

NOTE: This article is written by Noble James W. Hart, Sr. with much of the information coming from conversations with Jimmy Howell and also 3 articles that he had written previously and provided to the writer. Khedive Shrine Temple also provided information as well. As the writer of this story, I too will admit that I have had tears composing this article largely due to me knowing Jimmy the way that I do and knowing his passion for this philanthropy, his compassion for people and his faith in God.


