As many of you know, I've chosen Shriners Children's Greenville and their Build-A-Bear program as the recipient of the proceeds raised through my First Ladies Project this year. For those who are not yet familiar with this program, let me take a moment to explain. When a child comes to the hospital for their first surgery, they are brought to the Bear Den where they can choose a stuffed animal and an outfit. After their surgery, they return to their room, where their new friend is waiting, dressed in the outfit they picked out. The staff at Greenville go above and beyond, customizing the animals to reflect the child's own medical experience. The stuffed animal may wear the same cast or medical equipment as the child, offering comfort and familiarity. Each time the child returns for treatment, they get to select a new outfit for their animal. The joy on these children's faces when they hold their new friend is priceless and a true reminder of why we do this work.



To kick off the year, I've started selling heart-shaped necklaces featuring an infinity symbol at the center. The heart symbolizes the two hearts on my First Lady's pin—the larger representing all of us, and the smaller representing the children we care for. The infinity symbol represents the endless love we have for our work. These necklaces are priced at \$40 each, and I'm thrilled to report that, in just a month and a half, we've sold out of the first 100 we ordered! We are currently awaiting our next shipment. We're also selling "Shrine Life" t-shirts in red, pink, blue, and green. These t-shirts are \$20 for sizes small to XL, and \$25 for 2XL and 3XL. A big thank you to everyone who has already supported this initiative – we're off to a wonderful start.

Additionally, we will be hosting a "Style It Forward" dress sale on May 9th, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. I invite all Ladies to come out with their Noble and enjoy breakfast before the Business Meeting and dress sale. Lastly, we're excited to announce a Spring and Fall Flower Sale. For the spring, we'll offer begonias, impatiens, marigolds, and a variety of other beautiful flowers. 


KHEDIVE MOTOR CORPS

Mecca: An Historic Visit

By Illustrious Oscar Manuel Obsuna, P.P. 2019

In 1870, there were several thousand Masons in Manhattan, many of whom regularly lunched at the Knickerbocker Cottage, seated together at a special table on the second floor. It was there that discussions began about forming a new fraternity for Masons—one that would emphasize fun, fellowship, and camaraderie. Walter M. Fleming, M.D., and William J. Florence took this idea seriously enough to bring it to life.

Florence, a world-renowned actor, was once invited while on tour in Marseille to a party hosted by an Arab diplomat. The entertainment resembled an elaborately staged musical comedy, and at its conclusion, the guests were initiated into a secret society. Fascinated, Florence took extensive notes and sketches during this experience and on two subsequent occasions—once in Algiers and once in Cairo. Upon his return to New York in 1870, he shared his materials with Fleming.

Inspired by these experiences, the group adopted a Middle Eastern theme and soon established Temples (a term now generally replaced by Shrine Auditorium or Shrine Center). The first Temple established was Mecca Temple, now known as Mecca Shriners, founded at the New York City Masonic Hall on September 26, 1872. Walter M. Fleming served as its first Potentate.

On January 17, 2026, a distinguished delegation traveled to New York to commemorate this historic legacy. The group included 24 Brothers from Virginia, 15 Nobles from Khedive Shriners, members of the Scooter Patrol, Drum and Bugle Corps, and the Legion of Honor, led by Illustrious Sir Oscar Manuel Obsuna, P.P. 2019, along with nine Brothers from Victory Daylight Lodge No. 1778.



At 7:00 PM, a public installation ceremony for Illustrious Potentate Paul Guerrero was held at the Masonic Hall, located at 71 West 23rd Street, New York, NY 10010. Guests from AAHMES, ALOHA, AGILA, ALMAS, CRESCENT, KHEDIVE, KISMET, and MABUHAY Shriners—along with friends, family members, and dignitaries—gathered to witness an extraordinary event.

Khedive Shriners were formally recognized for having the largest delegation present and for presenting the most gifts during the occasion. Adding to the honor, an honorary membership was conferred upon Illustrious Paul Guerrero, signed and sealed by Illustrious Sir Randy Murphy and Recorder Wayne Kelly. Our delegation’s presence, participation, and representation were truly second to none.

All Nobles of Khedive Shriners in attendance were presented with a Hadji Certificate, Mecca’s version of an honorary membership. Notably, no other Temple present received this distinction.


