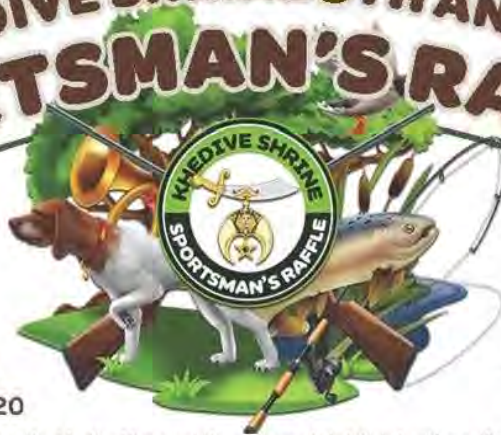

Get your petitions in. Our Ceremonial weekend will be September 23rd – 24th. With the Uniformed Units' Ball on the 24th.

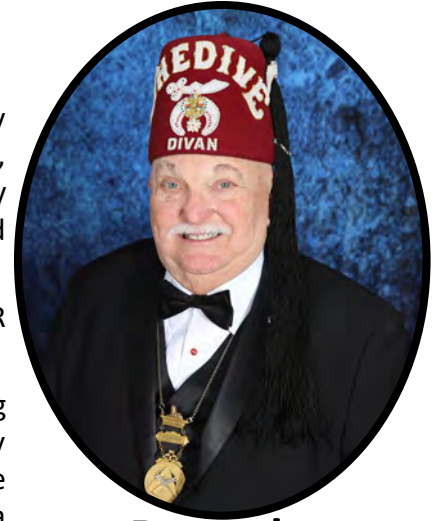

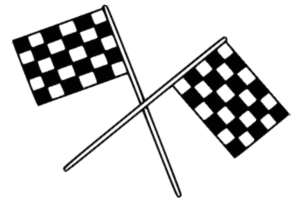

We chartered a 55-passenger deluxe motor coach from AGAPE Travel and Tours, which provided us a safe, comfortable seven-hour ride from Newport News to Greenville S.C.



We, unfortunately, had a few last-minute attendee cancellations and departed at eight o'clock on Friday morning with twenty-nine attendees. We arrived late afternoon at Greenville's Drury Hotel, checked in, and then went to the Greenville Shriners Children's Hospital for a Meet and Greet two-hour reception. The Hospital staff had prepared a well-organized, interesting program where we were introduced to the doctors and support people who provide the procedures and care of the children who are called "Shriner Kids". We then had personalized guided tours of the facilities where we had the opportunity to meet some of the Shriner Kid patients and their parents and to see some of the high-quality medical machines that are used to provide the unique treatments for the kids.

The program ended with a presentation in the Hospital Board Room and lunch at the Hospital cafeteria. Our group boarded our bus, and our highly talented driver transported us safely back to Newport News, arriving at 9:30 pm on Saturday night.

Hope Haven is now closed and no longer does Union Mission require the funds to operate this entity. Since the Blue Pete Haven Annual Hunter's Feast has always been about supporting the needs of children, they have agreed to commit to a financial contribution to the KRD and the Khedive Shrine Center for the good of our Philanthropy. Much more regarding this exciting opportunity will be forwarded once we get all the details worked out.

Greeting Nobles, Ladies and Fan Club Members,

Khedive Drum & Bugle Corps

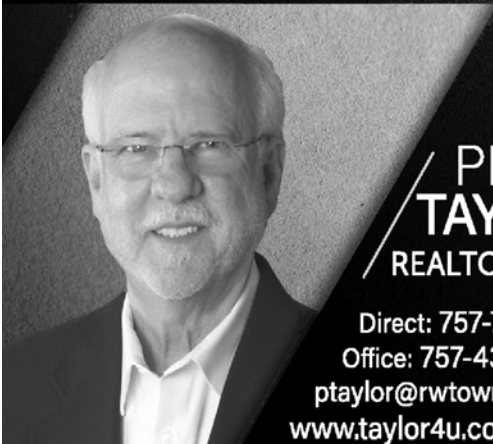

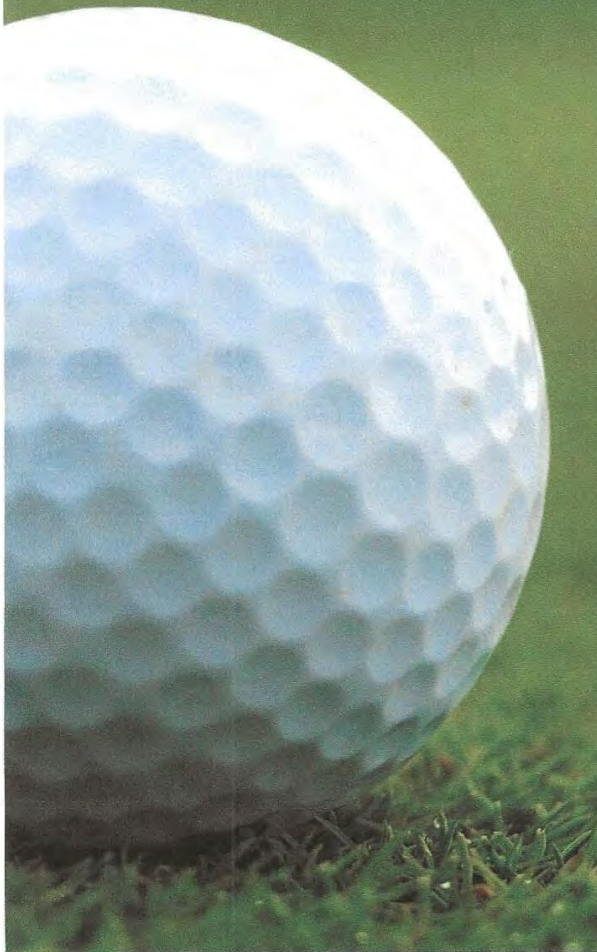

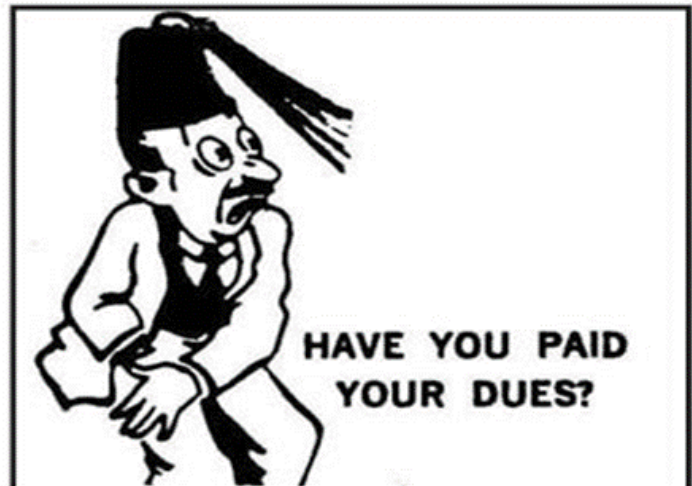
