



#### Our Nursing Team's Commitment to Patients Extends Beyond Exceptional Medical Care

Our nurses are truly extraordinary and essential to making Shriners Children's such a special place, going far beyond their professional promise to provide compassionate, high-quality care. The support they provide during a child's time with us helps build lasting relationships. They're that crucial link to families and are deeply committed to a child, and their family's, overall well-being.



For the nurses at Shriners Children's, it's all about

treating patients, not conditions. Our patients and their families overwhelmingly agree that our nursing team makes their overall experience with Shriners Children's a positive one.

#### **Supporting Those Who Are Vital to Our Success**

Because this team is such a crucial piece of our ability to provide amazing care to children everywhere, we must support them as much as they support our patients. Shriners Children's leadership is committed to providing our nurses with the tools, education and advancement opportunities that help them thrive professionally. Our nurses, including our per diem nurses, have access to a range of online continuing education programs. These programs are designed to help them maintain their license requirements, while promoting ongoing education and providing access to professional courses that prepare them for national specialty certification exams.

We also cover the cost of national certification exam fees and offer tuition reimbursement for training and professional development programs that our nurses engage in to advance their careers.

Nurses throughout the Shriners Children's healthcare system are highly trained and educated. At the end of 2020, 80% of our direct care nursing staff held a bachelor's degree in nursing or higher. Many healthcare organizations have yet to accomplish this milestone, which the **National Academy of Medicine** recommends as its standard for a direct care nursing workforce.

Today, our nursing leadership team is aligned with the **Future of Nursing 2020–2030 National Academy of Medicine** and the **Robert Wood Johnson Foundation** on the strategic vision for nursing, to promote advanced nursing education and professional certifications.

Each member of our team possesses unique expertise and skills. We encourage them to use these talents to help us advance and guide the way we care for patients and their families. One way we support this is through the integration of Interprofessional Collaborative Practice (IPCP) into our team's systems.

The IPCP approach to workforce culture supports and encourages communication and collaborative decision-making, along with promoting shared knowledge and skills among teams. Our nurses highly value this approach because it allows those on the frontlines to contribute to how we shape and define our policies on a larger scale.

With our partners in organizational development and learning strategy, we are also creating an internal nurse manager professional development program using the American Organization for Nursing Leadership (AONL) competencies standards. This program is based on the Nurse Manager Learning Domain Framework that promotes evidence-based clinical practice. This development program will span three countries, 15 states and approximately 60 nurse managers throughout the Shriners Children's healthcare system.

#### PROPOSED CHANGE #1

**ARTICLE VII** 

#### **DUES**

Section 1. Each member shall pay the sum of \$115.00 \$170.00 annually in advance for dues and such assessments as may be properly and lawfully imposed of which \$20.00 dollars will be applied to the Building Fund.

Section 2. Candidates admitted to the Temple shall pay dues as follow; Between January 1st. and March 31st, \$115.00 \$170.00; between April 1st and June 30th, \$90.00 \$145.00; between July 1st and September 30, \$65.00 \$120.00; between October 1st and December 31st \$40.00 \$95.00, which proportionate amounts shall constitute the dues of the candidate. (Above dues in addition to assessment mentioned in Section 1 above.)

#### PROPOSED CHANGE #2

**ARTICLE VII** 

#### **DUES**

Section 1. Each member shall pay the sum of \$115.00 \$140.00 annually in advance for dues and such assessments as may be properly and lawfully imposed of which \$20.00 dollars will be applied to the Building Fund. Dues for 2027 would be \$154.00, and 2028 would be \$169.00

Section 2. Candidates admitted to the Temple shall pay dues as follow; Between January 1st. and March 31st, \$115.00 \$140.00; between April 1st and June 30th, \$90.00 \$115.00; between July 1st and September 30, \$65.00 \$130.00; between October 1st and December 31st \$40.00 \$95.00, which proportionate amounts shall constitute the dues of the candidate. (Above dues in addition to assessment mentioned in Section 1 above.)

## **ACL TEAR**

An anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) tear is a common knee injury treated in Shriners sports medicine clinics.

An ACL tear can happen because of:

- Stopping suddenly while running
- Slowing down while running
- Changing directions quickly while running
- Jumping or landing incorrectly
- Contact injuries, such as a football tackle
- Overuse of the leg for jumping, running, twisting or pivoting

It is common for a child with an anterior cruciate ligament tear to hear a pop or for their knee to give out when the injury happens. Pain and swelling are very common after an ACL injury.

ACL injuries generally occur in teenage athletes and are much less common in younger children. Sometimes, another knee injury will happen at the same time as the ACL injury.

Appointments for anterior cruciate ligament injuries begin with a history and physical exam. Our doctors need to learn how an injury happened before deciding on a care plan. During the first visit, your doctor will look at the injury and test range of motion to see how well the arms or legs can move.

Radiology and rehabilitation are important for ACL injury care. At Shriners Children's we offer both, allowing convenient back-to-back appointments for our patients. X-rays or other images may be needed to help the doctor decide how to best treat the anterior cruciate ligament injury.

Children are not little adults – we recommend they see an orthopedic specialist who knows a child's bone structure and growth plates



# **Tidewater Shrine Club**

Greetings from Shriners Children's-Greenville! The accompanying picture is from a check presentation made at the hospital by Tidewater Shrine Club in January. Pictured left to right is Noble Scott Traner, Noble President Rick Taylor, Noble Keith Webb and Chairman of the Board of Governors Bobby Simmons. The donation was to honor Noble Jon Beck, a long-time member of Tidewater Shrine Club who has headed up more projects for the Club than can be counted, and has held various offices, including President. Jon was selected as Shriner of the Year for 2024, and donations were made in his honor for this presentation.



If any Club or Unit would like to make similar donations directly to the hospital, contact me and it can be arranged. The Board meets on the last Monday of most months.

Greenville continues to be among the best within the hospital system. The hospital has won the nationally prestigious Guardian of Excellence for Patient Experience and Physician Engagement award, given by Press Ganey for the past several years. Within the hospital system, our draw on the endowment continues to be among the lowest, making Greenville very close to being self-sufficient, based on January reports.

Greenville has begun addressing the needs of foreign children as well. We currently have teaching clinics in Cypress and El Salvador. Each year a team of Shriner medical professionals travel multiple times to these locations where they see patients, teach doctors and medical staff how to perform surgeries or care specific to our specialties. As with domestic patients, no child is turned away based on their parent's ability to pay. As you might imagine, the insurance coverage in some areas does not match coverage here in the U.S. so the endowment helps cover those expenses beyond what insurance covers. Some foreign governments pay for their patients as well. Greenville, as of January, had 6 foreign patients. The Ronald MacDonald House, nearby, provides housing during treatment for the families. It has been a great relationship between the 2 organizations. Remember, we are an international fraternity!

March 7-8, 2025, will be Shriners' Day at the hospital. This year that date conflicts with our Potentate's Ball. However, in future years, this event will occur on the first Friday/Saturday in March, so please plan accordingly. This is a great opportunity to see behind the scenes at the hospital, meet patients and doctors as well as hang out with about 400 other Shriners. If you haven't been to our hospital, you're missing a great opportunity to fill your heart with gratitude. Thank you for all the support as I represent our Shrine Center at Shriners Children's-Greenville.


