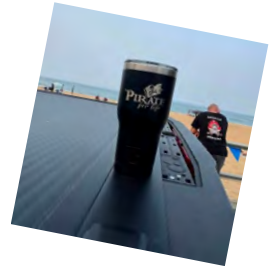
Khedive Swashbucklers

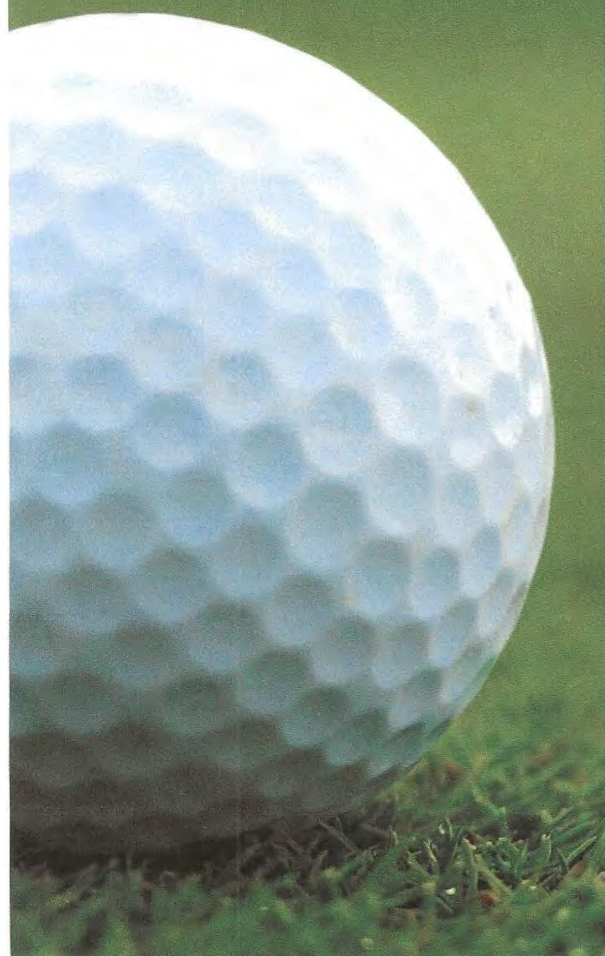

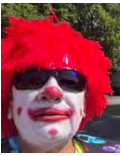

Did you Know... There are three major classes of clowns:



White face: Think of famous white face clowns such as Bozo and Ronald McDonald – the basic face starts with 'clown white' and then has exaggerated features such as high eyebrows and bright widened red lips. The costumes tend to be bright and amusing, often with exaggerated collars and sleeves.



Auguste: (pronounced: awe-goost) Famous Auguste clowns include Lou Jacobs and Albert Fratellini – the basic face starts with a skin tone makeup, and then uses red, white, and black tones to emphasize the muzzle and eyes. As a persona, Auguste clowns are jokers, often using bizarre props or pranks to get a laugh. Costumes for Auguste clowns are generally exaggerated suits or other attire, mostly done in outlandish colors or patterns.



Tramps: Emmett Kelly Jr. and Red Skelton's Freddie the Freeloader are two great examples. The traditional North American Tramp face and attitude typically is "careworn" or even "sad", and often appears unshaven or unclean. The costuming also appears to have "seen better days". In contrast, Hobo clowns are "happy tramps" and have a cheery demeanor in spite of their apparent hardships.

Occasionally, a clown will assume a Character persona, for example, a train engineer, jester, or keystone cop. While the costuming and props will reflect the character, the make-up can be taken from any of the three major classes.

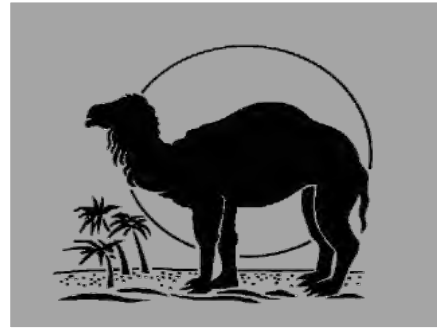

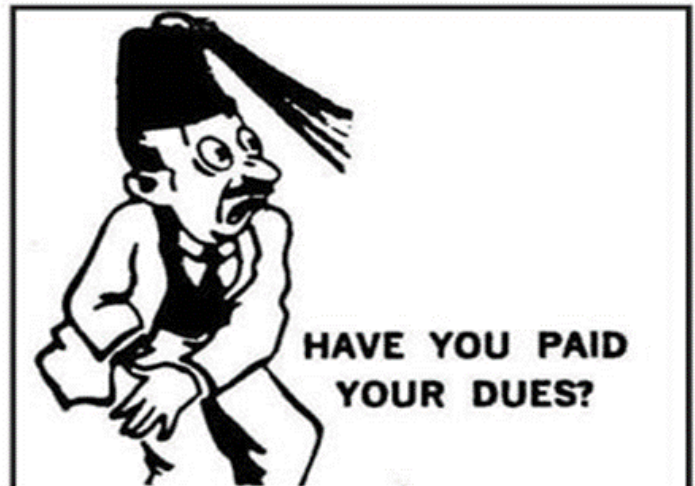
